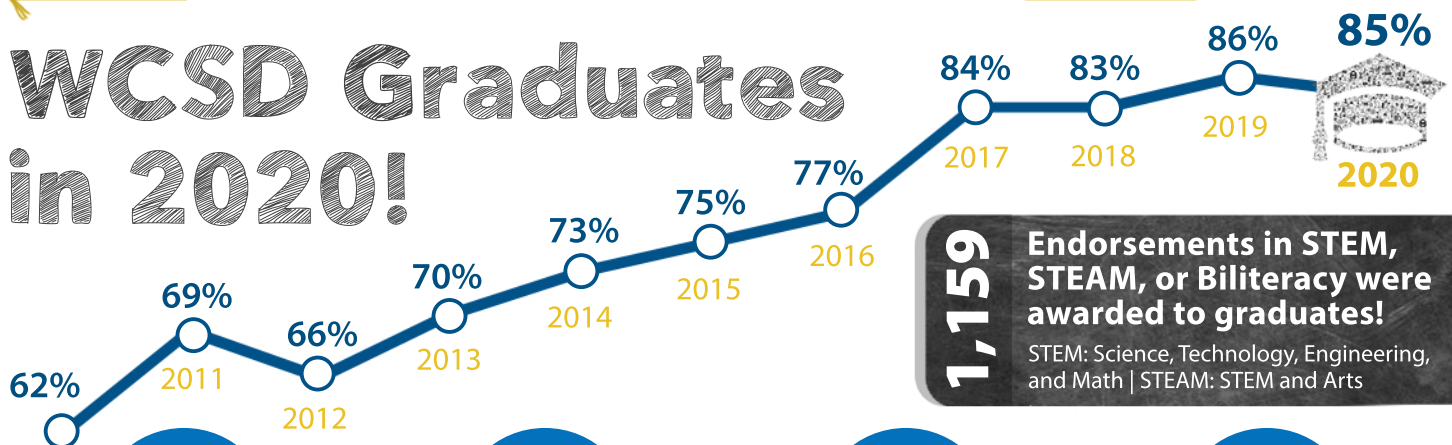

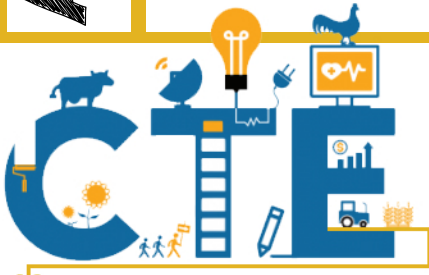

WCSD increased its percentage of students accessing career and technical education (CTE) courses annually since 2017! Nearly one-fourth of our 2020 12th graders were considered "CTE Completers."

To be considered a CTE completer, students must complete 3 years of study in a rigorous curriculum specific to a particular career and/or technical field.
